



Local Rules

1. Out of Bounds

- Beyond all hedges and fences forming the boundary of the Course.
- Within the confines of the Par 3 course. Within the confines of the driving range.
- All the area of the Car Park & Clubhouse.

Out of Bounds marked by White Posts a. On the left side of the 1st tee. b. On the left side of the 3rd/12th tee.

- At the rear of the 6th/15th green. On the right side of the 7th/16th tee.
- On the left of the 8th/17th fairway.
- At the rear of the 9th and 18th greens. On the left of the 9th/18th fairway. g. On the left of the YTM FOR FOR WAY.

 If a ball is out of bounds, or lost, stroke and distance relief **must** be taken, with one penalty stroke, by playing a ball from where the previous stroke was made. Rule 18.2b

If your ball may be out of bounds or lost please play a provisional ball

2. Safety Fences Safety fences to the right of the 1st tee, to the right of the 3rd tee and to the left of the 6th tee are integral parts of the course. Relief only with penalty under the unplayable ball rule. Rule 19.2

3. Penalty Areas

The walkway island in the middle of the pond approaching the 4th/13th green does not form part of the penalty area

4. Ground Under Repair (GUR)

If the ball lies in an area marked GUR relief **must** be taken, without penalty, by dropping a ball within one club length of the nearest point of complete relief. Rule 16.1b

5. Cultivated Garden Plots & Trees

If a ball lies in a garden plot containing garden flowers or shrubs, or in bark chippings surrounding the base of a tree, or if garden flowers or a staked tree interfere with stance or intended swing, relief must be taken, without penalty, by dropping a ball within one club length of the nearest point of complete relief. Rule 16.1f

6. Paths, Posts & Sprinkler Heads

If a ball lies on or close to an artificial surface, road or path (excluding the car park area), or close to a fairway direction post, ball washer post, bell post or sprinkler head so as to interfere with stance or intended swing, then relief **may** be taken, without penalty, by dropping a ball within one club length of the nearest point of complete relief. Rule 16.1b

7. Power Lines

If it is known or virtually certain that a player's ball hit a power line or it's support during play of the 8th/17th hole, the stroke does not count and the player **must** play a ball without penalty from the original spot. Rule E-11.

8. Range Balls

Range balls found on the course must not be used and should be returned to the office

9. Health & Safety

Please do not take balls out of the ponds or stand on the banks of the ponds when wet.

10. Public Right of Way

Courtesy should be given to all users.

11. Environmental Policy

At Woodside Golf we strive to enhance the environment and increase wildlife habitats, and request consideration at all times. Please do not discard litter or cigarettes or disturb nesting birds.

12. Temporary Local RulesTemporary local rules are displayed at reception and on notice boards.
